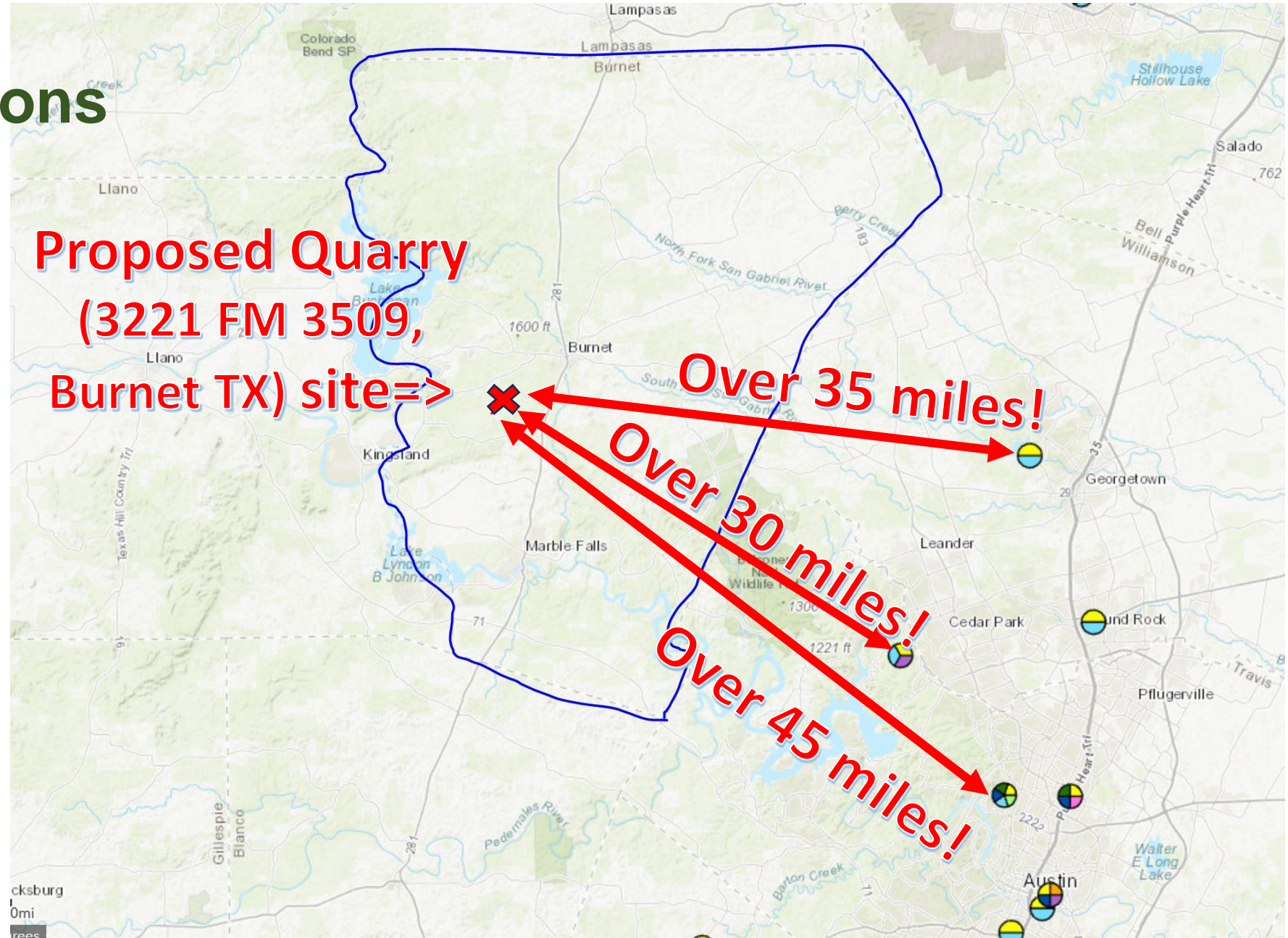


TCEQ air monitoring locations

- There are over 15 Rock Quarries in Burnet county, yet there are NO air Quality monitors in Burnet County!
- Closest Air Monitoring stations is upwind and miles away
- Audubon society in Leander, Texas is over 30 miles from proposed Rock Crushing Site. This site has not had validated data since September of 2024.
- Corp of Engineers at Lake Georgetown, Texas is over 35 miles away from proposed Rock Crushing site, and it only measures Temperature, Ozone and wind.... Not Particular Matter (PM or dust).
- Closest air monitoring station that is active is located at 3824 North Hills Drive, Austin Texas. Over 45 miles away and upwind from proposed site.



TCEQ air monitoring locations

- The map on the right is from TCEQ's website. The pink circle represents a 45-mile radius around the closest Particulate Matter (PM) air monitoring stations.
- Per the National Weather service most of the year the prevailing winds are from the Southeast. This means the location of the proposed rock crushing plant will be exactly upwind from the closest monitoring station which is located in Austin.
- You will also notice on the map that towns down-wind (Burnet, Llano, Lampasas, Lake Buchanan, Inks Lake and others) have a chance of receiving harmful levels of dust while the closest TCEQ monitoring station will never detect the potential hazard to the citizens of these affected communities.
- It was stated that the Rock Quarries or APOs will self monitor themselves and report any non-compliance. This is like posting speed limit signs and having no law enforcement officers anywhere in the area. Can you imagine drivers turning their self in for speeding and then paying a fine or having corrective action? Yeah, me neither.
